



Educator Guide: How to Launch California Community College Application

Goal

Students will launch the California Community College application from CaliforniaColleges.edu in order to apply to college and track their progress from within their account on CaliforniaColleges.edu.

Student Materials

This activity does not include a lesson plan. Instead, it is a resource worksheet for students applying to college and tracking this process from within their accounts on **CaliforniaColleges.edu**.

Tips for Educators

- 1. Ensure that students know how to log in to **CaliforniaColleges.edu** and have a copy of their transcripts.

Tracking Application Completion

- Students can track all college applications within their My Plan on CaliforniaColleges.edu. Educators with accounts on CaliforniaColleges.edu may have access to associated reports, based on permissions assigned by their site administrator.
- Application submission dates for **CCCApply** are verified dates. The dates are populated for students upon completing applications when they launch from within their accounts on **CaliforniaColleges.edu**.





Launch CCC Application from CaliforniaColleges.edu

Goal

You will launch the California Community College application from CaliforniaColleges.edu in order to apply to college and track your progress

What is CCCApply?

- CCCApply is the application you use to apply to all of the California Community Colleges.
- When you launch this application from within your account on **CaliforniaColleges.edu**, your application statuses will be reflected in **My Plan**.
- By launching your application within your account on **CaliforniaColleges.edu**, you and your counselor can track your applications.

What should I do before I launch CCC Apply?

- 1. Sign in to CaliforniaColleges.edu
- 2. Before launching CCC Apply, check the Academic Planner to see if you have a CCC tab:

How do I launch CCCApply?

- 1. Hover over **College** at the top of the page.
- 2. Under Launch from CaliforniaColleges.edu click on California Community Colleges Application.
- 3. Type the name of the college or select it from the dropdown list.
- 4. Click on the blue **Launch** button.

Note: It is recommended that you use a personal email that you check regularly – not your school-issued email address – when you create your CCCApply account.

Follow all directions to complete and submit your application. When you launch **CCCApply** from **CaliforniaColleges.edu** the date of the application submission will be recorded in the **College Applications** section of **My Plan**.
