

# The A-G Requirements

The California State University (CSU) and University of California (UC) systems both require that students complete at least 15 courses, in the subject areas listed below, to be eligible for admission. Courses must be completed with a grade of C- or better. Coursework beyond the minimum is strongly recommended.
